

# Write a Script | Build a Set

## OVERVIEW:

There are two choices for this 300-point project. The first choice is to write a script for our final production. The second option is to build the set for our final production. It is up to you which project you choose. However, you will be graded each day on your performance. This means that if you are not working, you will lose points. This project amounts to 50% of your grade for Quarter 2. It is important that you choose the project that will work best for you.

## OPTION 1:

If you choose to write the script, you will work with another individual to write a 25-minute play. You and your partner will either be adapting “The Legend of Sleepy Hollow” or “The Sword in the Stone.” A script template with specific instructions will be provided. The script must be completed by the project due date.

Option 1 has an alternative choice: Adapting the “Seasons” myth to become a 10-minute play and writing the introduction and intermission script. (You will work closely with Mr. Moore if you are assigned this part of the project.)

## OPTION 2:

If you choose this part of the project, you will be working very closely with Mr. Moore and Ms. Michelle on the art components of our set. This option is very hands-on and will be perfect for students who want to be up and moving throughout the class. This option, however, requires a great deal of self-direction and patience. Your tasks will change daily and you have to be willing to take direction and work cooperatively with our team.

**GRADE:** 300 Points Total, 30 each day: 10 for active participation, 10 for on-task behavior, and 10 for positive contributions and quality work product each day.
